

The Drug Free Schools and Communities Act and the US Department of Education's regulations require each participating institution of higher education to develop and implement a drug and alcohol abuse prevention program.

1) Regina Webb Academy actively supports the prevention of alcohol and drug abuse. The possession, use sale, manufacture or distribution of any controlled substance or alcohol on campus is prohibited.

2) Institutional penalties for violation of the above policy will result in expulsion. In addition, local law enforcement will be notified. Possible criminal penalties could include but are not limited to; monetary fines and/or imprisonment depending upon the severity of the charges.

3) Possible health risks associated with the use of drugs and alcohol include but are not limited to; Heart attack, stroke, or circulation issues; Damage to the lungs or sinus cavities; Damage to the liver and other vital organs; Possibility of infections and illness are possible depending upon the methods of use; Death or permanent disabilities are also possible.
