

Regina Webb Academy is a recipient of HEERF. An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

HEERF are funds provided to distribute to students for expenses related to the disruption of institution operation due to Covid-19 (including eligible expenses under a students cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare and childcare).

Per the U.S. Dept of Education the institution has the ability to determine its policy within specific guidelines.

Amount of HEERF to be divided evenly amongst qualified students: \$22,053.00

Regina Webb Academy will be distributing the HEERF funds in two disbursements.

FIRST DISBURSEMENT: Will be for those students that meet the requirements as of 6/26/2020.

SECOND DISBURSEMENT: each payment of \$1,470.20 will be held in a reserve fund for students that are not currently qualified per below requirements on 6/26/20 but have the ability to become eligible/qualified by 9/26/2020.

In the event there are remaining funds after distribution of all qualified students, the remainder will be evenly distributed amongst ALL qualified students from both first and second disbursement.

Date of Distribution for the below qualified students: 6/30/2020

A qualified student is defined as:

- A student that was actively enrolled/attending during the institutions disruption on March 18, 2020 due to COVID 19, prior to all students being placed on LOA
- A student that will return from LOA on or before 6/18/2020
- A student that is enrolled in a Title IV Eligible Program (program min. 600 hours)
- A student that is in good standing (meeting SAP)

Date of Distribution for the below qualified students: 9/30/2020

A student that is not on probation or warning (failing SAP) or who is not on LOA on 9/26/2020 is eligible under the following conditions:

- A student that was actively enrolled/attending during the institutions disruption on March 18, 2020 due to COVID 19
- Student has returned from LOA on or before 9/26/2020
- A student that is enrolled in a Title IV Program (program min. 600 hours)
- A student that is in good standing (meeting SAP) by 9/26/2020 (including those qualified students who graduated between 6/26/2020 and 9/26/2020)

A student that does NOT qualify for HEERF are defined as follows:

- A student that was NOT actively enrolled/attending during the institutions disruption on March 18, 2020 due to COVID 19 but either did not return from LOA on or before 9/26/2020 or has had their enrollment terminated and is incomplete on or before 9/26/2020
- A student that is NOT enrolled in a Title IV Program (program min. 600 hours)
- A student that is in NOT good standing (meeting SAP) by 9/26/2020

Updated 9/26/2020

Total amount of HEERF Grants distributed to students in the amount of \$1,470.20 for the first disbursement totaling \$16,172.20. The second disbursement will be in September distributing the remaining balances to those students that are eligible.

Total number of students that are or could be eligible and received the grant at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 is 15.

Total number of students who have received the Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) is 11 for the first disbursement on June 30, 2020. The second disbursement of the remaining funding will be disbursed to the students that are eligible on September 30, 2020

UPDATED 9/27/2020

On 9/30/2020, the remaining \$5,880.80 will be disbursed as follows: One student who was unqualified for the first disbursement has met all requirements. This student will be disbursed her first payment of \$1,470.20 – The remaining balance of \$4,410.60 will be divided equally amongst the remaining 10 qualified students. Each student will receive \$441.06 – This leaves a balance of \$.06 as of 9/30/2020 – (4 students did not qualify for the final disbursement)
